PROMOTING THINKING DURING PLAY

engaging with children



Help children to think deeper about the topics you're exploring by engaging with them during play! Use open-ended questions to challenge and develop children's thoughts and ideas about what they're learning. You could ask children:

- ➔ How do you think scientists discover information about dinosaurs from fossils?
- ➔ Can you move like a dinosaur?
- ➔ Do you think the world looked different when dinosaurs existed? How might it have been different from now?
- ➔ What might have happened if dinosaurs still roamed the Earth today?

LINKING TO THE LEARNING BEHIND PLAY

You might find children engaging in the following learning outcomes from the EYLF:

- ➔ Take a step into the shoes of a palaeontologist by setting up your very own dig site in the sandpit. Then give children brushes and other tools to help unearth the hidden bones.
