PROMOTING THINKING DURING PLAY engaging with children

Help children to think deeper about the topics you're exploring by engaging with them during play! Use open-ended questions to challenge and develop children's thoughts and ideas about what they're learning. You could ask children:

- 💿 Do you remember what order Stick Man went on his adventure, can we try to retell his adventure?
- How would you feel if you were apart from your family? How can we show others how much we care about them?
- 💿 What adventures have you been on? Can we make a playspace about it? What kind of things can we use?
- Can you tell me about your home? What do you love about your home?

extension ideas and prompts for continued inquiry



- Go out into nature to look for stick men! Activate children's imaginations and look for sticks that could be their very own stick men, get creative and adorn them with eyes or make accessories for them too!
- Stick Man rescue, freeze a Stick Man in a tray and give children resources to try and chip away the ice to rescue Stick Man.
- Take Stick Man on an adventure into your outdoor space, build sand castles, float him and find a real family tree.
- Encourage families to explore the story at home and share the Stick Man movie free to view on ABC
